It is with deep love and sorrow that we announce the passing of our beloved Alexis Rodriguez, who entered the arms of the Lord on August 30, 2025. Alexis lived a life filled with joy, compassion, and resilience. A 2021 graduate of Freeport High School, she was a member of the swim team and a gifted violinist. An avid reader, she also found fulfillment volunteering her summers in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Mt. Sinai South Nassau Hospital before her illness.

Music was one of Alexis’ greatest loves. She cherished the songs of Billie Eilish, Queen, Harry Styles, Panic! At The Disco, and many others. Whether singing into her microphone, jamming with Kim, or learning lyrics on YouTube, Alexis immersed herself in music. She especially loved attending concerts and fully embraced every performance, rocking out with pure joy.

Her loyal dog, Rocket, rarely left her side—snuggling with her during movie nights and TV marathons of her favorite shows, including Stranger Things, You, Supernatural, and Twilight. Wherever Alexis went, Rocket went too.

At just 16 years old, Alexis was diagnosed with Lafora Disease, a rare and fatal form of epilepsy. Through her 5½-year journey, her devoted mother, Altagracia (“AC”), provided unwavering love and care. Together, they created countless cherished memories—exploring New York City landmarks, attending

concerts, visiting amusement parks, taking trips to Florida, and, most recently, experiencing the joy of surfing at Long Beach with the help of dedicated volunteers.

Alexis shared a deep and special bond with her father, Benny. She adored his taste in classic rock and freestyle music, treasured his hugs and kisses, and loved spending time with him on the boat or stopping by simply for a hug. Both devoted NY Mets fans, they enjoyed cheering for their team together.

She also held a special place in her heart for her therapists—Melissa, Loretta, and Courtney—and health aide, Lena—who became not just caregivers, but friends and extended family, surrounding Alexis with love and encouragement through the years.

Family gatherings were a source of joy for Alexis. She loved dancing, laughing, eating, and celebrating with her large family, including her aunts, uncles, and cousins. From parties and holidays to reunions and trips, every moment spent together was treasured.

The family extends heartfelt gratitude to all who supported Alexis with prayers, kind words, and contributions to her GoFundMe campaign.

Alexis' radiant smile touched every heart she encountered. Though her time on earth was far too short, her spirit lives on in the love she gave and the lives she inspired. We find comfort knowing she now rests in God's embrace, smiling down on those she loved.

She is survived by her devoted mother, Altagracia ("AC"), and her devoted father, Benny; maternal grandmother, Juana Quiroz; maternal grandfather, Marcelino Lora; and paternal grandmother, Maria Rodriguez.
