June 25, 1922 - January 28, 2024

Charlotte Bean, 101, passed away peacefully in her home on Sunday January 28, 2024. Charlotte was born in Virginia on June 25, 1922, to Ernest and Etta Grasty. Charlotte was raised in Ohio with her siblings and loved being part of a large family. She loved telling stories about her childhood, going to the movies with her siblings, going out dancing with her sisters, sometimes even breaking the rules.

As a young adult Charlotte moved to New York where she met her husband. On Christmas day in 1945, Charlotte married Algernon Bean. Together they had nine children, five girls and four boys. Charlotte was a wonderful Christian mother, doting on her large family and was happiest when surrounded by her children. In 1967 at age 42, Charlottes husband Algernon died. Charlotte was left to raise her children on her own. Family members offered to raise some of her children as their own, but Charlotte refused to separate her children. She never remarried and devoted her life to ensuring her children had everything they needed to grow up strong, with great morals and values. These values were passed down to her 18 grandchildren and numerous great and great, great grandchildren.

Charlotte loved Broadway plays, Alvin Ailey Dance Theater, shopping, Atlantic City, plants and flowers. She loved Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas, cooking big meals and inviting friends and family to eat at her table.

When Charlotte's children grew into adulthood, she became involved in the Theodora Jackson Senior Center. Charlotte loved the activities at the center,

made new friends, joined the dance group, put on fashion shows, sang, traveled and eventually became President of the Advisory Board. The center was her happy place.

At almost 102, Charlotte led a good, prayerful, eventful life. She outlived all her siblings as well as three of her children. In the end, she longed to meet her God and reunite with her family in Heaven.
