Fanny Dominguez lived a life of service, devotion, and boundless love. Her story began in Bogota, Colombia, where she joined the Order of Our Lady of Peace as a young teenager. Through her years of religious life, Fanny discovered a passion for teaching and a dedication to community service that would guide her throughout her life.

Her journey took her to many different cities across Colombia, where she continued to touch the lives of those around her with her infectious spirit and unwavering kindness. In 1976, Fanny made the difficult decision to leave the convent and pursue her dream of becoming a high school teacher and hospitality and tourism manager.

In 1983, Fanny moved to New York City, where she met Carlos Dominguez, the love of her life. Over the next 33 years, they shared a beautiful journey together, living in different states and experiencing all the joys and challenges that life had to offer.

Fanny had a remarkable gift for connecting with people and making them feel

at ease. She loved socializing and was always quick to make new friends. She found a calling volunteering at Atlantic Care Hospital in New Jersey for over a decade, where her bright smile and warm personality brought comfort and joy to everyone she encountered, earning her the trust and appreciation of all who knew her.

Throughout her life, Fanny faced many health battles, including breast and stomach cancer, and ultimately ALS. Despite the challenges, she never lost her spirit or her determination to live life to the fullest. On February 8, 2023, surrounded by loved ones, Fanny passed away peacefully in her home.

Fanny will be deeply missed by her brothers Jaime Ayala, Humberto, Ricardo, and Fabio Uribe, sister Gloria Cordoba, nieces, nephews, and countless others whose lives she touched. Her memory will be cherished, and her spirit will continue to inspire those who knew her.
