James Thomas Blaney of New Port Richey, FL died suddenly on January 2, 2024, at his sister's home in Freeport, NY.

Born in Manhattan on October 11, 1952, Jim was raised in Freeport and went to Our Holy Redeemer School. He attended high school at Brooklyn Prep and graduated from St. Ambrose College in Davenport, IA, with a degree in Audio Engineering.

Jim worked alongside his father, Jim Sr., as an Audio Engineer for NBC television for many years. During his retirement in Florida, Jim volunteered with the Red Cross, as a Guardian ad Litem and was a member of The Florida Governor's Hurricane Conference.

An avid scuba diver, sailor, boater, and motorcycle enthusiast, Jim loved the outdoors but most enjoyed spending time with his children, grandchildren, neices and nephews.

Jim is survived by his children Shannon Blaney (Brad Branham) and Colin (Melissa) Blaney; grandchildren Emma, Conor, Grace, Liam, Molly, and

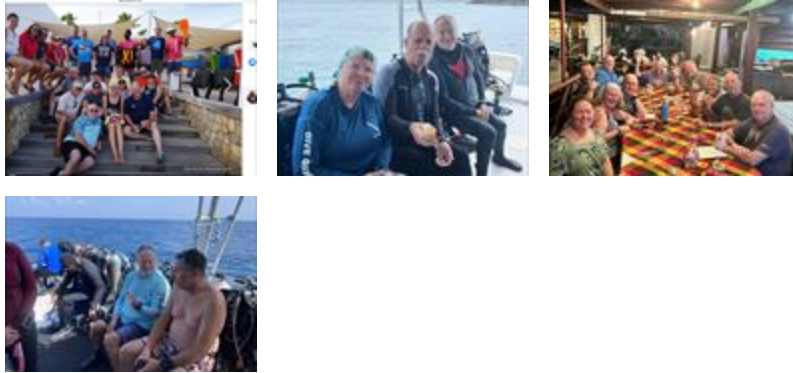
