On Wednesday, June 5, 2019, Lyndon Nigel Roger Thomas, son, brother, and uncle, passed away suddenly at the age of 51 at his residence in Tucson, Arizona.

Lyndon was born November 26, 1967 in San Fernando, Trinidad. His aunt Daphne was a School Vice Principal and he was fortunate to attend various prestigious schools she was transferred to. The last school he attended in Trinidad was St. James Secondary School before migrating to Toronto, Canada to join his mother. After a few years of residence in Canada he decided to come to New York to live with his father. After attending college and working part time as a stock broker, Lyndon enlisted in the military in 1992, and served two terms in the Persian Gulf War and was later stationed in Kosovo. He was honorably discharged in 2000 and made Arizona his second home. His final ranking in the army was Sergeant.

He is survived by his father and step-mother, Cyrus and Betty Thomas; and his six siblings: Sabrina Thomas, Tika (Rabiyah) Harding, Michelle Thomas, Nneka Harding, Colin Harding, and Cyrus Thomas Jr. Lyndon will also be forever remembered by numerous nieces and nephews, aunts, uncles and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his mother Yoland Lynette Taylor Harding.

Lyndon truly lived life to the fullest through simple pleasures; chatting, joking, and kidding with friends and family. Lyndon had an uncanny ability to reach people in a deep and positive way. He was a loving son, and sibling and never ended a conversation without saying "I love you". Lyndon, we love you and will always miss you.
