Manzie Roy Floro was born January 12, 1930, in Hanover Parish, Jamaica. Roy, the son of Matthieu Floro and Olga Donaldson, peacefully departed this life on September 12, 2025. Roy received his certification in Accounting by the London Chamber of Commerce in 1956 and pursued his career as an accountant at Jamaica Library Service, Goodyear and Alco in Jamaica. Roy married Elaine (nee deMontagnac) in 1960 and together they had three children. The family moved to the United States in 1968 and ultimately settled in Freeport, New York. Roy continued his accounting career at Avon, Thyssen, and finally retired as Director of Finance at the Roosevelt Community Mental Health Center.

Roy was a dedicated and active member of St Georges Church in Hempstead, serving on the Finance Committee and assisting with the Food Pantry. He loved to fish, travel and work on his cars. He loved a good party, making mixtapes (reel to reel) and made an awesome rum punch, although he did not drink.

Most of all Roy loved his family. He is preceded in death by his parents, his sister Joyce Davis and brother, Vernon Floro. He is survived by his wife, Elaine; his children, Gregory (Nissa), Andre, and Tanya (Sherman); grandchildren Adin, Kyle, Karis and Hunter. His sister Doris Mckenzie and many beloved nieces and nephews.

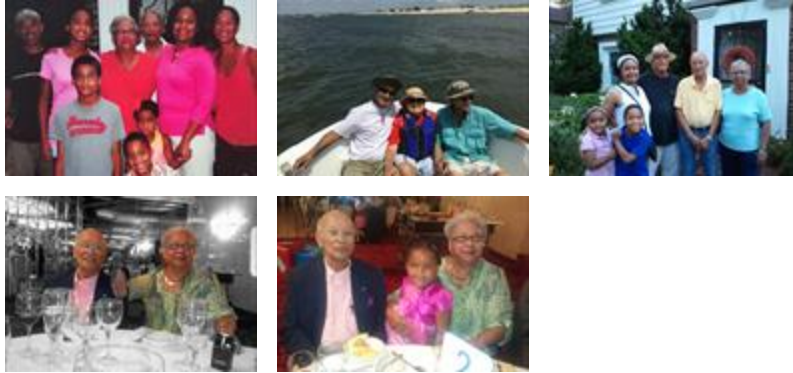
