Then Norene playing doctor again and piercing my ears with a sewing needle and thread. There’s Nor introducing me to 6-course family dinners, cannolis, linguini alla vongole. Next morning, cold linguine and soggy cannolis for breakfast. Who knew how great linguini with white clam sauce tastes cold? Also, Nor the pool shark, Saratoga, (losing all our money betting on her mother’s horses) and the unforgettable jockey parties her mom, Lee, made. Greyhound buses parked in the driveway at 12 Moraine, with its upstairs and downstairs kitchens, living rooms and dining rooms—yet she dressed like she didn’t have a penny. Nor taught me to push the envelope and never expect to be caught (though we usually were!). Life was an adventure and she was heroic. Whenever we were together we were teenagers again. Time stood still. I never imagined a time or a world without her. My condolences to Carl, Sophia, and Benedene, who were her universe. ❤️
