Rosine Marie Renken (nee Sinicki), 90, of Freeport, NY, peacefully passed away on May 16, 2023 in Mineola, NY. Rosine was born on July 8, 1932 in Binghamton, NY to Anthony and Mary Sinicki. She attended Binghamton Central High School before pursuing higher education at SUNY Cortland where she met her husband, Albert F. Renken.
