Steven Domingo Estrada, born in the Bronx, N.Y. on March 21, 1972, entered this world as a bright light destined to touch the heart of anyone he met. At three-years-old, Steven and his family moved to Freeport, N.Y., where his love of sports began. His first time up to bat was in Freeport Little League baseball, where both his father and uncle had the opportunity to serve as his coach.

After graduating from Our Holy Redeemer School, he attended Holy Trinity Diocesan High School, where he would join the baseball team. Upon receiving his diploma, Steven attended Nassau Community College, was a member of the baseball team, and then attended St. John's University.

He began his professional career at Long Island Jewish Medical Center as a unit assistant, working there for 11 years. Steven also worked at the Skin Cancer Foundation in order fulfillment management and was a direct support professional at HeartShare Human Services of New York.

He then had the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream of working in sports entertainment. Steven worked at MetLife Stadium, the home of the New York Giants, for 10 years, later receiving opportunities to work at Citifield, Yankee Stadium, and for The Madison Square Garden Company. Most recently, Steven worked at The Millennium Group and Volo Sports. Wherever he was employed, his coworkers became his friends.

Steven had a strong love of God, family, and friends. He was the quintessential good guy. His radiant smile lit up any room he entered. Steven passed away on Dec. 21, 2024.

He will live in our hearts forever.

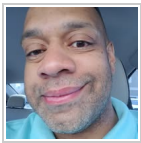
