He brought so much joy into the classroom and into our lives. I will truly miss him and always cherish those memories.

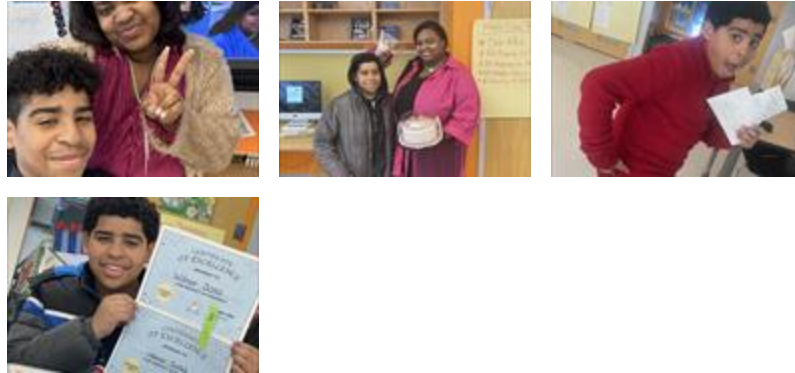
